This award is designed to help increase the public awareness of and support for 21st Century Scholars programs and services. Any school, non-profit, business, foundation or government agency is encouraged to submit a nomination.

Distinguished Alumni Award (Individual)

The Distinguished 21st Century Scholars Alumni Award recognizes an outstanding Alumni for his or her professional achievements, contributions to society and continued support to the 21st Century Scholars Program. Nominations will be open to any 21st Century Scholar Alumnus who has successfully earned a postsecondary credential.

Champion Award (Individual)

The 21st Century Scholars Champion Award recognizes individuals who have made essential contributions to the success of the 21st Century Scholars Program and the students it serves. Nominations will be open to any individual who has distinguished him or herself by advancing the 21st Century Scholars Program mission of college and career readiness and student success. Champions can be parents, family members, mentors, school administrators, school counselors, peer mentors, current Scholars and Scholars Alumni.

- ✓ A nomination essay (500 words or less) which outlines the following:
 - How has the 21st Century Scholars Program had an impact on your life?
 - In what ways have you been able to give back to the Program or your community?
- ✓ Two letters of support from executive staff, Scholar student or other staff member
- ✓ All award nominees will be asked to submit a high resolution, print quality copy of their organization's logo for publicity.
